Site rehabilitation after weeds are controlled- Spraying/ digging, alone, is not effective unless the noxious weeds have competition to prevent future infestations.

There are at least 50% established grasses/ native plants/ trees mixed with weeds to fill in once weeds are managed.
If there are little or no competitive plants in the infested area, you may rehabilitate the site with:
Dryland grass mix in late October or early November before winter snow.
Irrigated grass mix during the growing season when water is available.

I will monitor for weed re-invasion each year and re-treat weeds as necessary.
Ideally May 1, June 15, July 15, and September 15
