

**Resolution R-2013-22**

**ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE TASTING PERMITS  
IN LA PLATA COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, C.R.S. § 12-47-301(10) of the Colorado Liquor Code authorizes local liquor licensing authorities to issue permits for alcoholic beverage tastings as defined by the Colorado Liquor Code, to retail liquor store licensees or liquor-licensed drugstore licensees subject to the provisions of the Colorado Liquor Code; and

**WHEREAS**, owners of retail liquor stores in La Plata County have requested the County enact regulations permitting alcohol tastings in county retail liquor stores; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Durango allows alcohol tastings in retail liquor stores or liquor-licensed drugstores in the City, and establishing similar regulations in the County would create consistency for businesses in this area; and


**WHEREAS**, attached are proposed Standards for an Alcoholic Beverage Tasting Permit [Appendix A], amending Article III, Chapter 6 of the La Plata County Code; and

**WHEREAS**, it is proposed to amend Appendix A (attached) of the La Plata County Code to charge an initial application fee of \$100, and then have permit holders pay a \$25.00 permit renewal fee when they renew their liquor licenses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LA PLATA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LA PLATA COUNTY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The La Plata County Liquor Licensing Authority amends Article III, Chapter 6 of the La Plata County Code authorizing the permitting of alcohol tastings according to the Standards for Alcoholic Beverage Tasting Permits.
2. The La Plata County Liquor Licensing Authority amends Appendix A of the La Plata County Code to include an initial application fee of \$100.00 for an Alcohol Tasting Permit, and a Renewal Permit fee of \$25.00.


