Tastings shall be conducted only by a person who has completed a server training program that meets the standards established by the Liquor Enforcement Division in the Department of Revenue and who is either a retail liquor store licensee or a liquor-licensed drugstore licensee, or an employee of a licensee, and only on a licensed premise.

Written Control Plan demonstrating how tastings will be conducted to insure compliance with applicable requirements. Include diagrams if necessary.

LIST OF SCHEDULED TASTINGS:

Schedule must include dates, times of tastings, and assigned server.

The licensee may deviate from the approved schedule provided that:

1. the licensee gives the Liquor Licensing Clerk written notice no later than 10 days prior to the first day when an added or changed alcoholic beverage tasting will be conducted. This can be submitted by letter, or by email to: jan.mayergawlik@co.laplata.co.us
2. such deviation does not violate any provision of the County Code, the Colorado Liquor Code, Code of Regulations or any other state law or County ordinance or regulation.
