

30-10-717. Cash book – open to inspection. Every county treasurer shall keep in his or her office a record to be called the registry of county orders wherein shall be entered every sum of money paid to him by virtue of his office, the date of such payment, the name of the person paying the same, the account upon which the same was paid, the nature of the funds so paid to him, whether money, state or county scrip, or evidences of state or county indebtedness, and the amount of each separate kind. Such cash book, at all reasonable hours of the day, shall be open to the inspection and examination of all persons desiring to inspect or examine the same.
