



RESOLUTION NO. 2010-014

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
LA PLATA COUNTY, COLORADO, DESIGNATING THE HARRIS
RANCH TO THE COUNTY HISTORIC REGISTER**

WHEREAS, § 30-11-107 (bb), of the Colorado Revised Statutes empowers the Board of County Commissioners to provide for the preservation of cultural, historic, and architectural history within the County; and

WHEREAS, based upon the evidence and testimony presented at a public hearing on Nov. 15, 2004, the Board of County Commissioners of La Plata County found it desirable to create a Historic Preservation Review Commission, to establish a procedure for Designation of Local Historic Districts and Landmarks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Resolution 2004-33 to establish a procedure for the designation of appropriate historic sites and Historic Landmarks or Historic Districts, recognizing such designations to be an integral part of the preservation of cultural, historic and architectural history within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners appointed a three member Historic Preservation Review Commission; and

WHEREAS, on Feb. 9, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Resolution 2010- 09, increasing the membership of the Historic Preservation Review Commission from three to five.

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2010, the Historic Preservation Review Commission reviewed the Harris Ranch nomination, project 2010-022, and found this site to be of Historical significance to La Plata County and accordingly, the Historic Preservation Review Commission has presented to the Board of County Commissioners, its recommendation for inclusion of this site on the County Historic Register; and

WHEREAS, the La Plata County Board of County Commissioners held a duly noticed public hearing on the 30th of March, 2010, to consider whether the Board of County Commissioners should accept the recommendations of the Historic Preservation Review Commission; and


NOW THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION REVIEW COMMISSION, EVIDENCE AND TESTIMONY PRESENTED AT THE PUBLIC HEARING CONDUCTED THIS 30th DAY OF MARCH, 2010, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LA PLATA COUNTY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Harris Ranch, Project 2010-0014 is hereby approved for inclusion on the La Plata County Historic Register. Location is on San Juan National Forest Public Land parcel no. 5323-1740-00-025, south off FSA 578, (AKA Hermosa Park Road, AKA Rico Road), La Plata County CO., Section 22, Township 39N, Range 9W, further depicted in attached exhibit A & B.










USGS Quadrangle: Engineer Mountain
