

Do's and Don'ts for Families of Inmates

You May Do The Following:

MONEY

You may come into the lobby and put money in the Kiosk machine for Inmate's; using cash, credit or debit card.

You may call 888-497-2387 or use the web address www.ezmoneyload.com to put money on an Inmate's account.

You may bond out Inmates online: using this web address www.ezonlinebail.com

If you want to pay a debt after you are released, you need to contact a Detention Specialist at 247-1161 ext. 0 to activate your account. Then you can load money via the Kiosk, 888-497-2387 or web address www.ezmoneyload.com

VISITING

You may call 247-1161 ext. 2 between the hours of 8:30 am to 11:00 and 11:30 to 4:00 pm Monday through Friday. Visitation will take place Tuesday through Saturday in 30 minute increments during the following times: 7:30 am – 10:30 am, 2:00 pm – 3:30 pm. and 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm. Inmates may only have one scheduled visitation per day. Visitors must call the day before they wish to visit to make an appointment. All visits will be video visitation. Only two visitors may visit an Inmate at a time. The only exception will be a child under the age of 2 years who can be held on the visitor's lap. Visitors must be 18 years of age or older unless accompanied by an adult. No Bags, purses, or other personal items will be allowed in the visitation area. Visitors are expected to arrive 10 minutes prior to their scheduled visitation time to check in. Visitors who arrive after their scheduled time has begun will have their visit cancelled. All visitations are subject to audio and video monitoring. **(You must wear proper attire: No string top, tube tops, or short midriff shirt and no short shorts, your visit will be denied if you are dressed improperly.)**

Scheduled visits are subject to cancellation without notice due to Inmate court appearances and other unforeseen circumstances

MAIL

You may write to your family member. Address it to: Inmate's name, 742 Turner Drive, Durango, CO 81303.

You may bring medical items approved by jail nurse only.

YOU MAY NOT:

Bring items for Inmates, no hand-delivered mail, all mail must be sent via postal service.

YOU MAY NOT:

Send anything via mail other than letters, and photographs. Photographs **can not** be Polaroids OR computer generated color paper. No extra stamps, writing paper, gifts, or books.

All books and newspapers must be ordered directly through the publisher

BOOKS FOR INMATES

You may purchase **New** books for inmates housed at the La Plata County Detention Facility. **New** books **MUST** be purchased from one of our approved publishers and sent directly to the inmate. The address the books should be addressed to is: 742 Turner Drive, Durango, CO 81303, include the inmate's name.

Interlata is in Colorado, outside the 970 area code. Ex: Calling Colorado Springs or Denver.

Interstate is calling outside of Colorado.

DON'Ts

YOU MAY NOT:

- Do not bring items for inmates, other than money and medical items **approved by jail nurse.**
- No hand-delivered mail - All mail must be sent via postal service.
- Do not send anything via mail other than letters, money, and photographs.
- Photographs can not be Polaroid.
- Do not send extra stamps, writing paper, gifts, or books.
- There are NO contact visits
- There is NO visiting outside of regular hours, unless approved by jail commander
